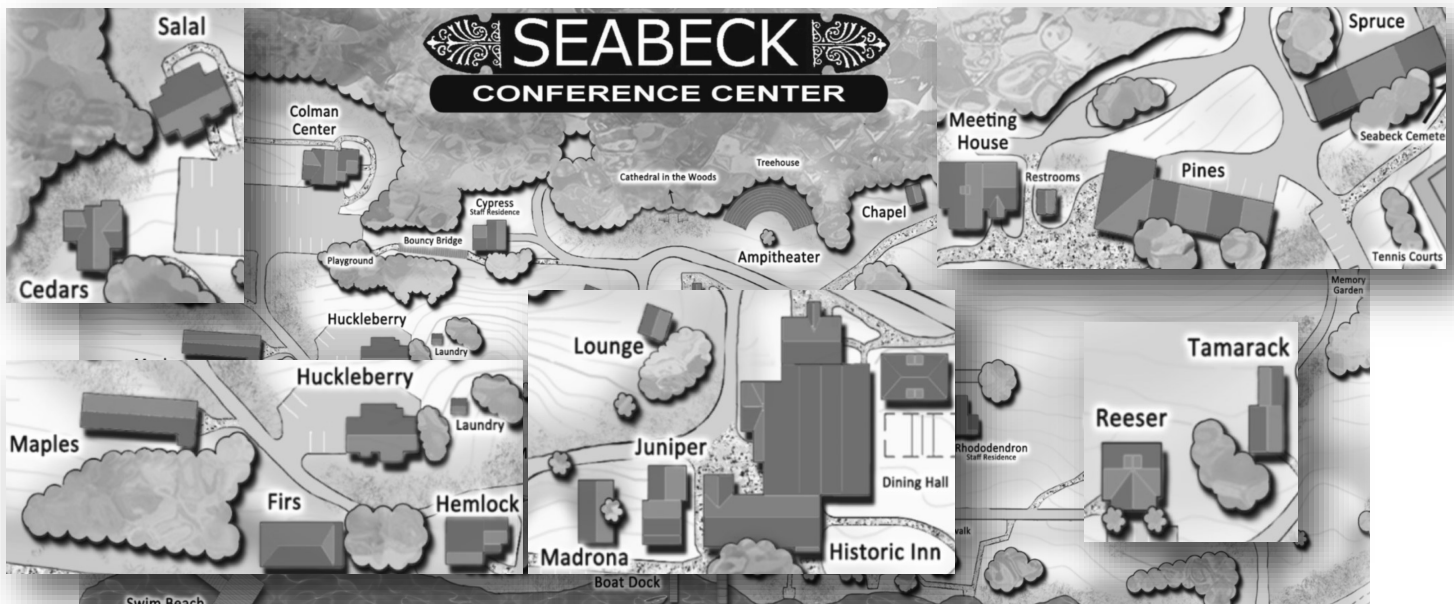

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East corner of conference center

Salal
2 story lodge. 8 rooms, 4 are handicap-accessible. Each room has two twin beds.
The rooms have a small desk and a ceiling fan.
2 rooms per floor have a connecting door between them, making it ideal for families. Each room has a private bath and independent room heating.

Cedars
2 story house has 8 sleeping rooms with 22 single beds, 4 double beds, and 2 shared bathrooms.

Lodging just North of the Inn

Huckleberry
2 story lodge, 8 rooms, 4 handicap-accessible. Each room has 2 twin beds.
2 rooms per floor have a connecting door. Ideal for families. Each room has a private bath and independent room heating.

Hemlock
2 story house, 5 sleeping rooms. 15 single beds and one double bed. 2 shared bathrooms.
1st floor is handicap-accessible with a large bathroom.
There are sinks in rooms 3, 4 and 5.
Small playground in front — ideal for small children.

Firs
Single story. 5 sleeping rooms—each has 2 single beds and 1 double bed and a ceiling fan. 2 shared bathrooms. Ideal for families with small children.

Maples
Single story. 8 sleeping rooms—each room has 2 single beds and ceiling fans. 2 shared bathrooms, centrally located in the building with an outside access.

Lodging at the center of the conference center

Historic Inn
Center offices, lodging, and dining room. The lobby is a social area for all guests, bathrooms, and 24-hour coffee service.
The 2nd floor, accessible by stairs, has 10 rooms with 18 beds. Two rooms have private baths, others share two large baths. Three rooms have sinks.

Annex
Down a hallway from the Inn, with 12 single-occupancy rooms and two shared bathrooms. (accessible by stairs only)

Inn #100
Handicap-accessible room is off the Inn Lobby with easy access to the dining room. 2 twin beds and barrier free shower.

Madrona
Two story house, 4 sleeping rooms with 10 single beds and two double beds. 2 rooms with private bath and 2 rooms with shared bath. Close to the Inn and Dining Room.

South corner of conference center

Spruce
Two-story unit with 13 sleeping rooms. 12 rooms have three beds each. One room on the meeting room level is wheelchair-accessible with two beds. All rooms feature private bathrooms.
The meeting room has a small refrigerator, and microwave.

Pines
2 story unit. 12 sleeping rooms. Each has 2 single beds and one double hide-a-bed couch. 2 shared bathrooms on each end of building. A handicap bathroom and rooms with wheelchair accessibility on the lower level.
Closest to the adult programming. Kitchen with refrigeration, stove, oven, coffee urns, and sinks.

West corner of conference center

Reeser
Three-story house. 8 sleeping rooms, total of 14 beds. Building has four bathrooms. One room, on 2nd floor, has a queen bed and private bathroom.

Tamarack
2 story house has 13 single beds and one double in 4 rooms, with 2 shared bathrooms
